## USE THE RBdigital APP TO CHECKOUT AND READ MAGAZINES ON A MOBILE DEVICE



- New users have to create an account online at the library [eDownloads](#) page by clicking on the RBdigital logo or visiting [www.rbdigital.com/lincolnli/service/magazines/landing](http://www.rbdigital.com/lincolnli/service/magazines/landing) (**Must do this before using the app**)
- Download the app, RBdigital from your devices app store: Apple devices(iPad & iPhone, etc.) use the [App Store](#), Android devices(Nook Color/Tablet, Samsung Phone/Tablet, etc.) use the [Google Play Store](#), and Kindle Fire devices (HD/HDX, etc.) use the [Amazon App Store](#).
- **Open the app and follow the prompts** to setup your app - **Select USA, Type the Username** that you created on the website in the first step, **Tap Next, Tap Lincoln Library in the list, enter your password and click Next.**
- **Checked out screen appears with current checkouts listed. Click on any of them to begin reading (Must be connected to Wi-Fi to download checked out items).**
- Search the collections by clicking on the  icon or Browse the collections by click on the menu icon  and clicking on the Magazines collection.
- To download an item click “Download”

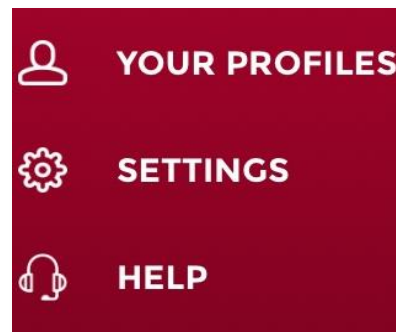
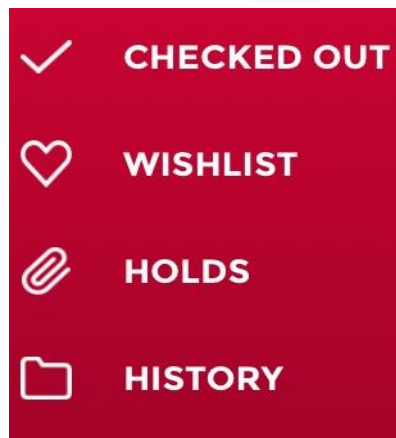
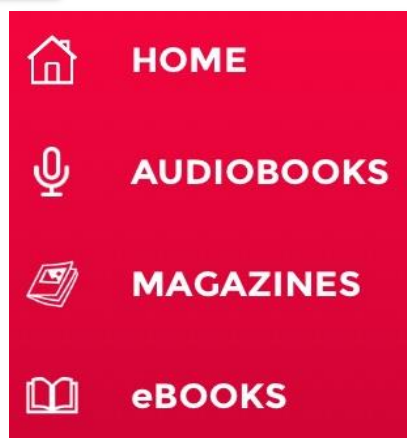
## NAVIGATING THE RBdigital APP
