



Visiting Lincoln Library's Mobile Branch




Lincoln Library's Mobile Branch is a vehicle filled with library books and resources.



The Mobile Branch stops at locations all around Springfield so residents can access library offerings throughout the city.

I can look at the Mobile Branch's schedule and choose a stop to go to for my visit.



There is a screen on the outside of the Mobile Branch.

It shares information. I can look at it and learn about upcoming library programming, Mobile Branch stops, and more.

Sometimes there is also music playing from the Mobile Branch's outdoor speaker.



I may be hungry during my visit to the Mobile Branch.

Food isn't allowed inside of the Mobile Branch, but I can eat my snack outside of the vehicle.



I can go into the Mobile Branch.

There is a door next to the screen that opens. That's one way to enter and exit the vehicle.

There are steps and handles that can help me get in safely.



If I use a wheelchair or other assistive device, I can enter and exit the Mobile Branch using the lift at the back of the vehicle.

A Mobile Branch employee can help make sure I get into the vehicle safely.



Inside of the vehicle, there are shelves lining both walls.

The shelves are filled with library items for all ages.

I can carefully remove items from the shelves to look at them more closely.



There is a Hold Shelf on the vehicle, so I can pick up my holds on the Mobile Branch.

In order to do that, I select “Mobile Branch” as my pickup location when I place my request through the Library’s website.

I only touch the items on the Hold Shelf that are my requests.



There are two benches on the Mobile Branch.

I can sit on them and look through the items I took off of the shelves.



There may be other people in the vehicle while I am there.

I can walk and move my body carefully when I am on the Mobile Branch.


I can share the space with others.



There are employees on the Mobile Branch.

The employees are there to help me and to answer questions.

At least one employee will be at the desk at the front of the vehicle. That is where they can help me check out (borrow) the library items I want to take home.



In order to check out items, I need my library card.



I take my items and library card to the desk.

The employee will scan my library card and the items I want to borrow.

Once the employee has scanned my items, I can take them home.

The employee may give me a receipt that says the due date for the library materials. That's the date by which I need to return my items so other people can have a chance to enjoy them.
