Construction of a new park bounded by 6th, Jefferson, 5th, and Adams Streets started in March 1987. Springfield Mayor J. Michael Houston's office called for suggestions for park names from Springfield residents. One hundred and thirty-one names were submitted. The Mayor appointed a committee to select a name for the park from those submissions. The committee chose the name "Union Square Park." The park was dedicated on November 9, 1987.
