FY20 Budget – The library's Fiscal Year 2020 budget hearing was held on Thursday, January 10. Director O'Hearn believes City Council will pass the budget with funds for a book mobile and a technological upgrade.

SameFest – SameFest is scheduled for Saturday, January 26, 11 a.m.to 4 p.m. The focus for the 2109 intercultural festival is storytelling.

LINCOLN LIBRARY FOUNDATION: Ms. Cox reported that the Lincoln Library Foundation Board has committed \$25,000 towards the purchase of a bookmobile. It is anticipated that the vehicle will cost approximately \$150,000, the balance of which will be provided by the city.

FRIENDS OF LINCOLN LIBRARY: The Friends annual winter book sale was held late afternoon on Friday, January 11 and all day on Saturday, January 12. Due to a significant winter storm, sales were slow. The amount raised will be shared at the next meeting of the Friends' Board.
